Furnace tune-up must be completed between September 1, 2025 and December 31, 2025. Customer is limited to one NMGC tune-up rebate every three years.

- One-time online ACH payments using a checking or savings account
- Credit and debit card payments using American Express, VISA, MasterCard or Discover
- Set-it-and-forget-it autopay and 24-hour interactive voice response payments
- In-person at any one of our 22 walk-in payment centers

Additionally, customers will continue to be able to pay by mail and through Western Union locations.

GAS PIPELINE SAFETY

New Mexico Gas Company maintains more than 12,000 miles of natural gas pipelines across New Mexico. According to the U.S. Department of Transportation, pipelines are the safest, most environmentally friendly and most efficient and reliable mode of transporting natural gas.

Here are some tips to help you stay safe:

Call Before You Dig. Call 811 at least three working days before you start a project that requires digging. New Mexico Gas Company will mark its gas lines up to the gas meter at no cost to you.

Recognizing A Gas Leak. There are several ways to recognize a gas leak, including an unusual hissing noise, a rotten egg smell, blowing dirt, bubbles appearing in still water, unusual dry spots on the ground or dead vegetation - all for no apparent reason.

What To Do If There's A Gas Leak. Leave the area immediately and, from a safe distance, call New Mexico Gas Company at 1-888-NM-GAS-CO (1-888-664-2726) any time of the day or night or call 911.

Hazards. Natural gas doesn't burn on its own, but it will ignite if there is a source of ignition such as a flame or spark. Striking a natural gas line could result in an ignition. That is why it is critical for your safety that you call 811 before you dig.

SEGURIDAD DE LOS GASODUCTOS

New Mexico Gas Company mantiene más de 12,000 millas de gasoductos de gas natural a través de Nuevo México. Según el Departamento de Transporte de los Estados Unidos, los gasoductos son el modo más seguro, más ecológico y más eficiente y confiable de transportar gas natural.

Aquí hay algunos consejos para ayudarle a mantenerse seguro:

Llame antes de excavar. Llame al 811 por lo menos tres días hábiles antes de comenzar un proyecto que requiere excavación. New Mexico Gas Company marcará sus líneas de gas hasta el medidor de gas sin costo para usted.

Reconociendo una fuga de gas. Hay varias formas de reconocer una fuga de gas, incluyendo un ruido silbido inusual, un olor a huevo podrido, tierra que está soplando, burbujas que aparecen en agua estancada, lugares secos inusuales en el suelo o vegetación muerta - todo sin razón aparente.

Que hacer si hay una fuga de gas. Salgase del área inmediatamente y, desde una distancia segura, llame a New Mexico Gas Company al 1-888-NM-GAS-CO (1-888-664-2726) en cualquier tiempo del día o de la noche o llame al 911.

Peligros. El gas natural no quemar por sí mismo, pero se encenderá si hay una fuente de ignición como una llama o una chispa. Golpear una línea de gas natural podría provocar un incendio. Por eso es crítico para su seguridad que llame al 811 antes de excavar.
