

#### WHO MAINTAINS YOUR GAS LINES?

At New Mexico Gas Company, your safety is our top priority. Should you need to dig or excavate, dial 811 at least three days before to request utilities mark their lines. NMGC is responsible for maintaining our gas lines up to the meter. Our responsibility ends at the meter. Any gas lines on the other side of our meter - such as the gas lines in your yard, home or building - are the responsibility of the property owner and should be inspected, maintained and repaired only by trained professionals. Regular inspections by a licensed plumber or heating contractor are crucial to check for corrosion and leaks. Any issues found must be promptly fixed. In addition to calling 811, before beginning any digging project you should also ensure a professional locates your gas lines beyond the meter and you should always dig carefully. # USE A GAS DETECTOR TO HELP DETECT NATURAL GAS

Residential methane detectors, also called gas detectors, are commercially available and are another tool that may assist in detecting the presence of natural gas. Gas detectors listed by the Underwriters Laboratories (UL) can be used as an extra measure of safety for detecting the presence of natural gas. Gas detectors emit a sound when gas is present and do not depend on sense of smell. These alarms must be installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.
